





2013 BILL

- AN ACT to create 710.13 of the statutes; relating to: notice of an instrument that
- 2 proposes to change a property line.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, a register of deeds is required to record documents related to real property if the documents satisfy certain requirements. Under this bill, if a person intends to record a document that proposes to alter a property line based on a survey or other professional services provided by a licensed land surveyor, the person must provide written notice to each person who owns property that is adjacent to the existing or proposed property line, including a copy of the document and any attachments, at least 30 days before the person submits the document for recording. The bill provides that the person may submit the document for recording earlier than 30 days after providing written notice to the adjacent property owners if the person obtains written waivers of the time period from each adjacent property owner. Under the bill, a register of deeds is not required to record a document that proposes to change a property line based on a survey or other professional services provided by a licensed land surveyor unless notice is provided to adjacent property owners as required under the bill.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

3 **Section 1.** 710.13 of the statutes is created to read:

LRB-1165/1 FFK:kjf&jld:jf SECTION 1

710.13 Notice of property line change. (1) If a person intends to record or file in the office of the register of deeds of a county a document that proposes to change a property line based on professional services provided by a registered land surveyor, the person shall provide written notice of the proposed change, including a copy of the document the person intends to record and any attachments, to each property owner who owns property that abuts the existing or proposed property line no later than 30 days before the date the person records or files the document. A person may record or file the document sooner than 30 days after providing the required notice if each property owner entitled to receive notice under this subsection waives the 30-day time period in writing.

- (2) (a) Notwithstanding ss. 706.05 and 706.085, a document described in sub.(1) is not entitled to record in an office of the register of deeds unless notice is provided in accordance with sub. (1).
- (b) A document under par. (a) shall include a signed affidavit of the person recording or filing the document that he or she provided the notice required under this section, or, if the notice was waived, the signed waivers shall be attached to the document for recording or filing.

Section 2. Initial applicability.

(1) The treatment of section 710.13 (2) of the statutes first applies to a document submitted for recording or filing in an office of the register of deeds of a county on the 31st day after publication.

- land record modernization for benefit of all in the state
- Originally the \$5 Redaction Fee was used to protect sensitive information by making it non-reviewable or accessible on the internet. The proposal would be to keep the fee and use the money to improve the Public Land Surveying System (PLSS) by digitizing land record documents housed at the Register of Deeds Office and make them available online. A couple counties have already dropped this fee while most are still using the fee.
