NEWSLETTER EDITOR REPORT (Jill Bostedt)*

- No report at this time

WSLS REPORT (Rick VanGoethem)

- Last Board meeting was January 29, 2016 in Lake Delton
- WSLs will join GeoLearn for a one year trial
- Emily Pierce is the 2016 WSLs President with Larry Miller elected as the President-elect
- 997 people were registered for the Institute
- There is now one (1) PDH for attending the Exhibit Hall instead of a session
- Discussed a recently proposed bill that would eliminate the Land Surveyors Section and only have one surveyor on the Joint Board
- Jim Sehloff is now the Chair of the Membership Committee (Congrats Jim!)
- Jerry Mahun will continue one more year as Chair of the Website Committee
- There is some discussion on restarting a survey program at Nicolet College – Education Committee will discuss and report back
- Next Board Meeting is scheduled for March 5 in Rothschild

- Lisa has decided not to run for another term (2 is enough). She accomplished quite a bit in her two terms and help change the organization for the better Thank You Lisa!

AUDITING (Terry Van Hout)

- 2015 Annual Report was received at the last General Meeting in January. A motion was made, seconded and approved to have Terry Van Hout and Ryan Duckart join the committee (No issue with them working with current Sec/Treas)

CST (????)

- There are 59 active CSTs in Wisconsin as of November, 2015
- NWTC will host an exam on March 9th at the NWTC campus. There are 12 students signed up right now

ETHICS AND PRACTICE (Tom Leslie)

- No requests or completed forms were received since the last meeting

LAND RECORDS (Ryan Duckart)

• WISCORS

State Legislature has authorized the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) to charge a Systems Maintenance Fee (Wis. Stat. s. 85.63 Surveying Reference Station System). WisDOT had a Stakeholders Meeting on December 10, 2015 and recently sent out a questionnaire to gather information on how to administer a Systems Maintenance Fee for the WISCORS Network. The fee is expected to go into effect after the Rule has been completed in State FY17.

WisDOT indicated that the fee would be based on the \$305,000 needed for annual maintenance. To offset this cost WisDOT would be looking at charging \$450 per customer per year assuming 35% of the 2,000+ current customers register for the system, but they will use the information from the questionnaire to help set that price. As of now, it is anticipated that each login will have to pay, but they are looking at company logins where multiple users would pay one fee

- **US FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE MAPS**

The Wisconsin Counties Surveyors Association (WCSA) became aware that the US Fish & Wildlife Service had surveys commissioned by them that were never filed in the counties where the survey took place. The WCSA contacted the US Fish & Wildlife Service to receive copies of the maps. In some cases the work that was done by the US Fish & Wildlife does not agree with or show different evidence that could affect past and future remonumentation efforts performed by the Counties. The maps were received by the WCSA and distributed to the following counties, Bayfield, Buffalo, Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Dunn, Fond du Lac, Grant, Jefferson, Juneau, La Crosse, Marquette, Ozaukee, Polk, Rock, Sheboygan, St. Croix, Trempealeau, Vernon, and Winnebago

- **STATEWIDE PARCEL MAP**

- **HARN STATIONS ENDANGERED**

There are 2 original HARN stations that are endangered due to proposed construction in Brown County. GREEN BAY GPS (PN1345) is endangered due to proposed ramp construction on STH 29 for a new overpass. GREEN BAY AZ MK (DL2579) is endangered by a proposed STH 29 interchange and improvements near CTH VV. It is not currently in the path of the proposed design, but it is close to it

- **WISCONSIN ACT 145 REAL ESTATE TRANSFER RETURNS**

Effective February 6, 2016 – requires the filing of real estate transfer returns for any conveyance of property, including those where there is no filing fee required. The only exception to this requirement is for conveyances dated prior to the creation of the real estate transfer fee law October 1, 1969. As amended, the bill also prohibits local fees from being imposed on conveyances that are exempt from the real estate transfer fee. This legislation affects conveyances drafted on or after February 6, 2016
