January 20, 2022 – The Woods in Green Bay, WI

The 2021 Fall General Meeting was held on January 20, 2022 at The Woods in Green Bay, WI. There were 43 members present, including 8 students, when Chapter President Howard Herrild introduced:

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

- Steve Swanson, Zoning Administrator, Dept. of Land Services for Outagamie County, discussed the County’s CSM Review Process. Chad VandenLangenberg, Land Use Specialist, was also scheduled to present, but could not make it. The presentation included the following:
 - Department currently has 13 employees, and has Code Enforcement Jurisdiction over 8 Chapters within the County Ordinances
 - Most Towns have adopted County Zoning
 - New County Surveyor & related website
 - GIS Maps & Property information website
 - County’s Permit Application Web Portal
 - Discussion on Preliminary CSM process


