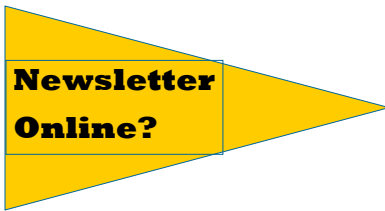

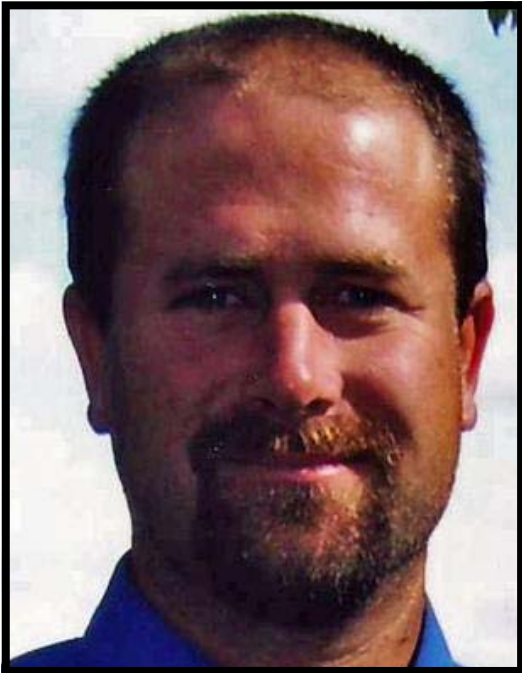

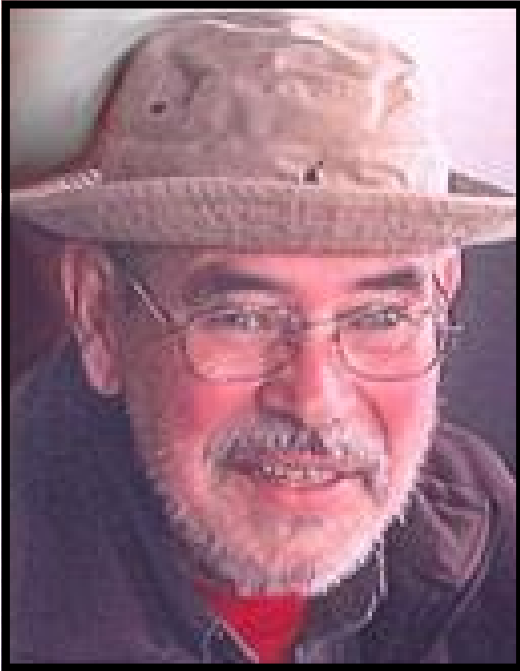
Mattrisch, Mark S.

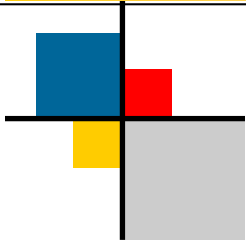

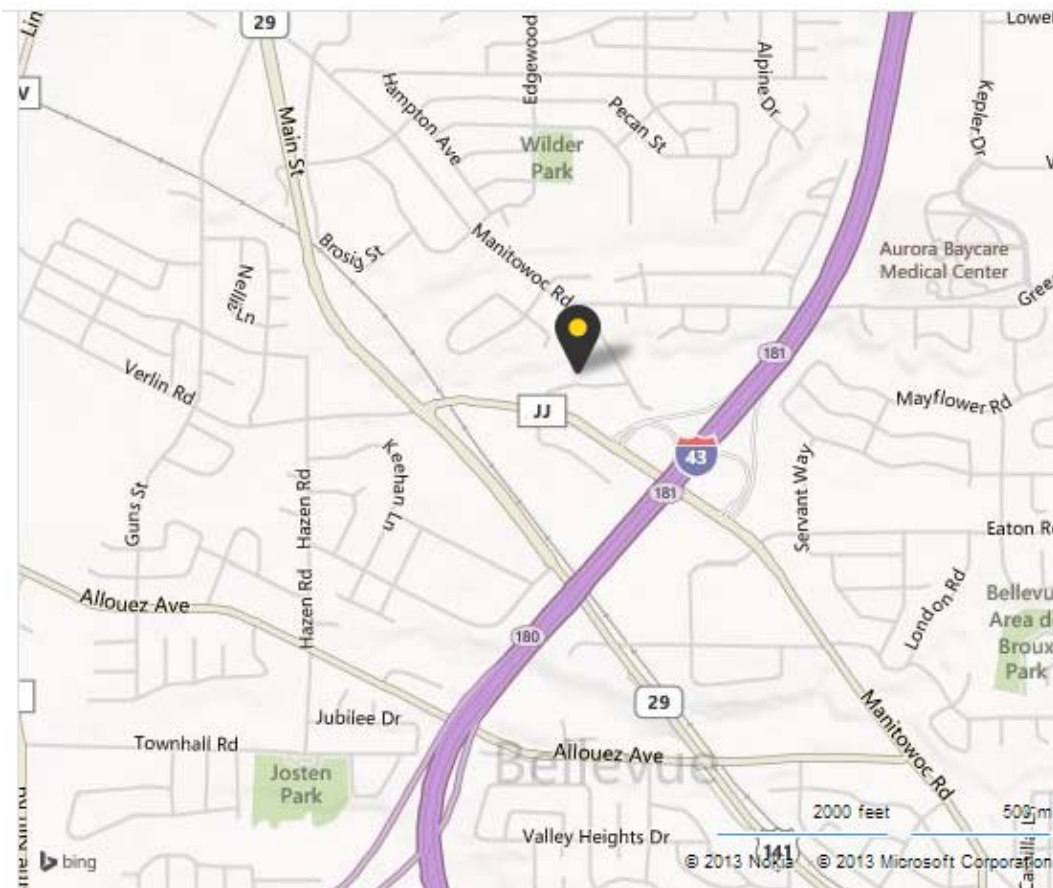

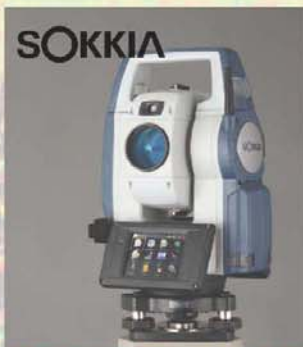
