



- Acreage below OHWM must now be given in total acreage
- CSMs MUST <u>ALWAYS</u> BE TIED TO PLSS
- City of Milwaukee played a huge part in now allowing CSMs to contain more than 4 lots, although certain restrictions will apply
- · No changes were made to County Plats
