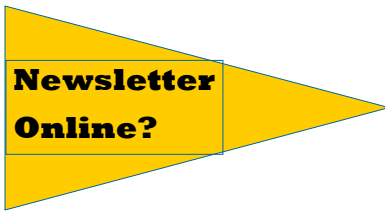

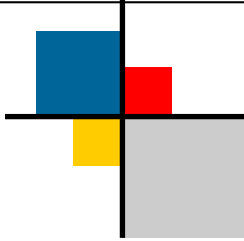

NEW BUSINESS

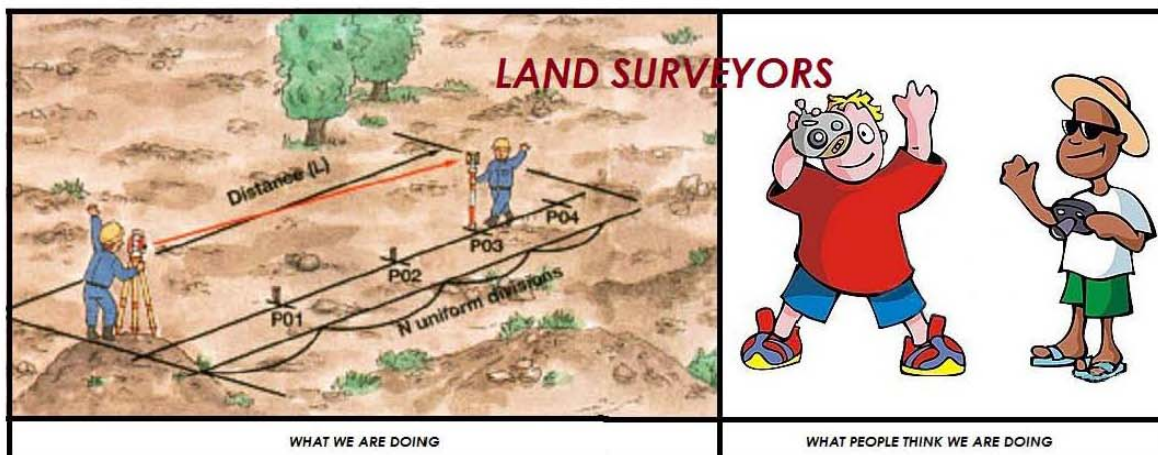
- Larry Miller was nominated and accepted as a Lifetime Member of the Chapter. Tom L will order the plaque for July meeting presentation
