



LAND RECORDS (Ryan Duckart)

• WisDOT Geodetic Survey Project – Recently, the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) negotiated contracts to start geodetic survey field observations in northeastern Wisconsin as part of the initial development efforts of the Wisconsin Height Modernization

Program with an anticipated start date of late April 2015. They are currently in negotiations for similar contracts to perform geodetic leveling in northeastern Wisconsin as well with anticipated start dates in June 2015. For this survey work, you may see 3-person leveling crews utilizing A TV's along the R/W as well as 1-person crews performing GPS observations on many geodetic survey control stations (survey monuments) that have been constructed in the ground over the past few years. These geodetic survey control stations are typically located within the R/W and marked by either white plastic posts or orange 4" x 4" guard posts. Survey work is currently expected to last through the end of the summer and possibly into the fall in this area of the state with multiple crews working simultaneously throughout the region.

The firms performing this work for WisDOT are:

Ayres Associates Patrick Engineering DJ Henkel & Associates

These are experienced and qualified firms that have performed geodetic leveling and/or geodetic survey field observation campaigns for WisDOT in the past in other regions of the state and are expected to have work zones clearly marked with orange signs (leveling crews) and/or with vehicles equipped with flashing amber lights.

• **GEOID12B** - On April 23, NGS released a new geoid model that is a revised version of GEIOD12A. The new model is known as GEOID12B. John Ellingson from NGS said that it is not necessary for you to change your GPS equipment/software to reflect the new model. The new model is EXACTLY the same as the earlier GEOID12A model in the fifty states (CONUS). The only change with the new version is that they have updated the portion (of the earlier geoid model) that covers Puerto Rico and the US Virgin Islands. So, unless you are surveying in Puerto Rico or the Virgin Islands, there is no need to make changes to your geoid model at this time.

An important point to remember.... You should only be using the GEOID12* model if you are working with NAD 83(2011) ellipsoid heights. If you are working with ellipsoid heights determined via earlier

adjustments of NAD 83, then you should use $\operatorname{GEOID03}$

Land Records (Ryan Duckart)*

 Fond Du Lac County has all Plats of Surveys, ALTA Surveys, Tract Indexes, Section Summaries and Tie Sheets available online, available for viewing/printing, no subscription or login required. They can be accessed by visiting the Fond du Lac County website-Departments-Surveyor- click on the links to plat of surveys. They are available for searching by section-town-range or by subdivision name. The entire subdivision name does not have to be spelled out. In searching section 1 – 9, the field must be typed in with two digits, (01) (02) ect. 1-9 are the biggest problem users are having in searching. Users can contact Peter Kuen with any questions through the Fond du lac County website. Manitowoc County has had tie sheets, Plats of Surveys, and section summaries online now for about 1.5 years. Brown County is still working on adding surveys in the City of Green Bay to their online index. The rest of the county is complete with CSMs, Subdivisions, and Plats of Surveys Florence County does not have a full time County Surveyor so the Register of Deeds serves as the place where surveyors can do research and get information to aid in their work. However, there is some concern that very few surveys and maps are being filed at the county. It is required by state statute to file maps in the county that they are performed in within 60 days upon completion, so if anyone has any work that they have done in Florence County, or any county, please be sure to file your surveys
