2016 SPRING GENERAL MEETING MINUTES

April 7, 2016 – The Distillery in Green Bay, WI

The 2016 Spring General Meeting was held on April 7, 2016 at The Distillery in Green Bay, WI. There were 55 members present when Chapter President Aaron Ballast introduced:

Special Announcement

Dennis Reim and Jim Wallen gave an update on the condition and progress of fellow surveyor and Northeast Chapter Member **Mark Teuteberg**. There is a donation bucket set up at the sign-in table, as well as a large "Get Better" card for all to sign and a sign-up sheet for the "Yard Clean Up day for Mark" coming up within the next few weeks. The Chapter wants to help out Mark and wife Bonnie as much as we can so everyone was encouraged to make a donation and sign-up to help with the yard cleanup. The card will also be brought to the next County Surveyors Association meeting coming up in early May, as well as emails being sent to alert WLIO and WSLs in hopes of procuring additional donations to the Teutebergs

A motion was made, seconded and approved to have the Northeast Chapter donate \$1500 to the Teutebergs

Special Presentation

Peter Menet, owner of Menet Aero, Inc., gave a presentation on Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) operations, including related applications, capabilities and regulations. He also spoke of how UAS can be integrated into certain aspects of the surveying profession.

Menet Aero serves many industries, including: Law enforcement, HAZMAT, firefighting, real estate, construction, power transmission lines, structural inspection.

There are numerous regulations and requirements related to the use of UAS (49 USC 40102, Public Law 112-95 Section 336, FAA Modernization & Reform Act of 2012 (Section 333), Aviation Innovation Reform & Reauthorization Act, Feb. 2016)... and that's just some of them!

Peter also discussed what authorizations and licenses that owner/operators are required to obtain before actual "in the field" operations, including COA, pilots license requirement, registering with FAA and the use of visual observers. He also spoke of Wisconsin Statutes 941 & 942, and its relationship to the use (or misuse) of UAS

President Ballast thanked Menet Aero for the very interesting presentation, and then called the General Meeting to order at 8:48 pm

A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the General Meeting minutes of January 7, 2016

A motion was made, seconded and approved to accept the Treasurer's Report as presented in the April 2016 Newsletter

Newsletter Editors Report (Jill Bostedt)*

WSLS Report (Rick VG)

- Board met twice since the Institute, January 29 and March 5 – next meeting is May 14
- Act 219, dealing with adverse possession against a municipality, has passed. Revised AE-7 is now in effect as well
- Northern Lakes Chapter will be hosting this year's Summer meeting on August 5-6 in Eagle River
- All Chapter Directors should be gathering names for nominations to next year's WSLs Board, including President-elect, At Large Director, Treasurer and NSPS Director – get your name into Rick if interested
- WSLS made a donation to help Mark Teuteberg

NSPS Report (Lisa Van Horn)

- 48 states are now part of the 100% initiative
- Capitol Hill Lobbying Day was a great success, with discussions including Workforce Development, flood insurance, Coastal Flood Act
- Please check out NSPS website for more information
- Young Surveyors now have an Affiliate membership in NSPS. There is a BIG push within NSPS to get more people into school programs and the profession

Auditing Committee (Tony Luloff)

- Committee returned the year end packet to Tom L. The Annual Report was presented at the last Board meeting, with a short report given tonight

CST Committee (Brad Nelson)

- No report at this time

Ethics and Practices (Tom Leslie)

- A complaint has been received and will be forwarded to the WSLs Ethics & Practices Committee for further review and guidance

Land Records (Ryan Duckart)

▪ **WISCORS**

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is currently reviewing and analyzing all WISCORS Stakeholder Questionnaire feedback. There are currently no updates to report regarding any potential fee, organizational/bulk rates or exemption statutes

US FISH & WILDLIFE SERVICE MAPS

The Wisconsin Counties Surveyors Association (WCSA) became aware that the US Fish & Wildlife Service had surveys commissioned by them that were never filed in the counties where the survey took place. The WCSA contacted the US Fish & Wildlife Service to receive copies of the maps. In some cases the work that was done by the US Fish & Wildlife does not agree with or show different evidence that could affect past and future remonumentation efforts performed by the Counties. The maps were received by the WCSA and distributed to the following counties, Bayfield, Buffalo, Columbia, Crawford, Dane, Dodge, Dunn, Fond du Lac, Grant, Jefferson, Juneau, La Crosse, Marquette, Ozaukee, Polk, Rock, Sheboygan, St. Croix, Trempealeau, Vernon, and Winnebago

HARNS STATIONS ENDANGERED

There are 2 original HARN stations that are endangered due to proposed construction in Brown County. GREEN BAY GPS (PN1345) is endangered due to proposed ramp construction on STH 29 for a new overpass. GREEN BAY AZ MK (DL2579) is endangered by a proposed STH 29 interchange and improvements near CTH VV. It is not currently in the path of the proposed design, but it is close to it.

WISCONSIN ACT 145 REAL ESTATE TRANSACTION RETURNS FOR EXEMPT CONVEYANCES

Effective February 6, 2016 – requires the filing of real estate transfer returns for any conveyance of property, including those where there is no filing fee required. The only exception to this requirement is for conveyances dated prior to the creation of the real estate transfer fee law October 1, 1969. As amended, the bill also prohibits local fees from being imposed on conveyances that are exempt from the real estate transfer fee. This legislation affects conveyances drafted on or after February 6, 2016

Legislative (Ed Harvey)

- Legislators are currently out of session so no real news to report
- AE-7 is now in effect. All surveyors should read the new code for revised regulations and conditions

Membership (Jim Schloff)

- Eugene Braun, long time Lifetime Member of the Northeast Chapter, has passed away recently. The obituary was sent out in an email to all paid members. A card from the Chapter will also be sent to the family

NEWSLETTER EDITOR REPORT (Jill Bostedt)*

WSLS REPORT (Rick VanGoethem)

- WSLs is looking for a Webmaster for the website
- There will be two vacancies on the DSPS Land Surveyor Section Licensing Board in the near future. See DSPS website for more information
- AE-7 rules and standards are NOT passed yet. The new one should go in to effect for several months, possibly sooner
- Discussion of WISCOR charging for services has been tabled until July 2017
- Using a survey to possibly stop an adverse possession claim was discussed
- FALL AGENDA includes Chapter Reps getting a list of nominations for WSLs officers. A bulletin will be added to the Chapter’s Fall Newsletter

CST (Brad Nelson)*

- NWTC’s CST exam on March 9th had 12 students test. 8 students passed, and 3 scores are pending until June. 65-70% test scores are put into “limbo” until the next CST Board meeting, which isn’t until late May, to make the decisions
- Online review CST test to prep participants is available online every semester

ETHICS AND PRACTICE (Tom Leslie)

- One request has been received. Discussions with surveyor are ongoing. Nothing else to report

LAND RECORDS (Ryan Duckart)

• **OUTAGAMIE COUNTY PLSS CORNER MAINTENANCE**

Recently letters were sent to the Outagamie County Board by the Wisconsin County Surveyors Association (WCSA), the Wisconsin Society of Land Surveyors (WSLS), Brown County and various surveyors to explain the importance of preserving the Government Corners. The Board is looking to save money by no longer funding the maintenance of corners. They believed that since they have coordinates on all the corners that the coordinates could be used in place of monuments

• **WLIP PROGRAM PLAN – Draft 2**

The Wisconsin Land Information Council (WLIC) met on March 24, 2016 to discuss Draft 1. In response to motions passed at the March 24th meeting, public comments received on Draft 1 and additional research and planning conducted by WLIP staff, DOA made several revisions to the first draft and created a Draft 2. The draft can be found on the WLIC website listed below:

www.doa.state.wi.us/Divisions/Intergovernmental-Relations/Wisconsin-Land-Information-Council

The key changes are included in Chapter 4:

- The funding formula was changed to allocate Strategic Initiative grant funds equally across all 72 counties.
- The Strategic Initiative grant priorities and benchmarks were changed, with a refocus on parcels, access to data, and PLSS
- The sections on data access were revised

Comments are due by May 27th, and will be compiled and discussed at the next WLIC meeting, currently scheduled for June 8th
