



April 11, 2019 – Suster's Arcade in Denmark, WI

The 2019 Spring General Meeting was held on April 11, 2019 at Suster's Arcade in Denmark, WI. There were 53 members present, including 2 students, when Chapter President Andy Cleveland introduced:

Presentation

Travis Stuck, Davel Engineering & Environmental, discussed recent changes in wetland regulations due to the new wetland laws. Discussion included:

- Differences between State and Federal definitions of wetlands: in natural state, no tilling or alteration of soils, vegetation, hydrology
- Two exemptions created by Wisconsin Act 183 (started March 20, 2018): Artificial wetlands boundary & Non-Federal
- Routine Wetland Delineation (RWD) reports which included numerous exhibits, may not be all that is needed for permitting purposes
- Triggers for requiring a RWD: artificial, Non-Federal, more than 1 acre, indications of wetlands using Google Maps, closed contours, closed depressions, existing before August 1, 1991
- Urban vs Rural



President Duckart thanked Travis for his very informative presentation on wetland delineation regulations

2019 SPRING BOARD OF DIRECTORS MEETING

May 15, 2019 – Skyview Club in Kaukauna, WI

There were 11 members present when President Ryan Duckart called the meeting to order at 6:54 pm

A motion was *made, seconded and approved* to accept the Board meeting minutes from February 21, 2019

Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented

The following reports were given: (* via email)

NEWSLETTER EDITOR REPORT (Jill Bostedt)*

- No report at this time

WLS REPORT (Jim Sehloff)

- The WLS Board last met on May 4, 2019
- GPS user fee was mostly met with negative comments but most believe the fee is coming
- A-E 6 Discussion – talk about opening to completely get rid of reference requirements. I believe this is very dangerous
- A-E 7: should be approved at the next meeting in October
- 703 Condominium: appears to be competing bill coming out from the ROD and Realtors Association, no drafts at this time for review
- NSPS was looking to see if there was any interest in a Certified Floodplain Surveyor (CFS) program in the state. It was suggested that it might possible WLS would hold a 2 day course for surveyors to obtain the certification. Currently only 2 states have this
- DOT is looking at a monument perpetuation plat. This would find all monuments and replace if disturbed. There would be no certification to the accuracy of the monuments just location as originally found prior to the project
- Possible partnership with GPS Education Partnership in promoting Surveying in High Schools. Concerns were cost of just getting started, and what other option were out there similar to this
- Bob Beilfuss is starting to work on the Strategic Planning
- Young Surveyors asked that all chapters add Young Surveyors to their meeting agenda to help get the word out on what they are doing
- Since the meeting 2 new bills have been introduced both have been sent to the memberships. They include the Construction Zone Safety Bill and Electronic Notary. There is nothing new since we sent these out

- Board voted to give politician time to speak the institute. This came up because Tammy Baldwin has sponsored several bills that help the survey industry and was very receptive to our representatives at lobbyist days

NSPS REPORT (Lisa Van Horn)

- "Women in Surveying" seminar will be held in August in Texas
- More emphasis is being made on getting kids more involved/interested in surveying
- "SaGes" or *Surveying and Geomatics Educators Society* reports that there are 145 schools in the Nation offer some sort of surveying related courses. More info can be found at <http://geosages.org/>
