2022 SPRING GENERAL MEETING MINUTES April 14, 2022 – Calmes Pub in Kaukauna, WI

The 2022 Spring General Meeting was held on April 14, 2022 at Calmes Pub in Kaukauna, WI. There were 36 members present, including 3 students, when Chapter President Ryan Beltrand introduced:

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

Paul Crocker, Project Manager at Ayres, presented on "UAS technologies and how they apply to the modern surveyor". He spoke of the different levels of available drones, what each one can (or should) be used or not used, depending on the project. He also discussed the overall state of drone use, for surveyors as well as other companies and how this technology is helping create a much safer way to "survey" the difficult areas for surveying (major highways, underpasses, remote areas, etc)

WSLS Report (Jim Sehloff)

- The board meet 3 times since our last meeting. Friday after the Institute; March 12 and April 7th for a special meeting This was President Harvey's last meeting prior to passing the gavel
- President Meyer has made a point to Celebrate the 70year anniversary of WSLS interception WSLS Donated 5k to the Bill Wambach Memorial
- The institute was very successful with over 600 in attendance and 150 virtually Federal Land Asset Inventory Reform "Flair Act" was introduced this bill claims to increase transparency, cut wasteful government spending, and help us manage our public lands more effectively
- There was discussion about a possible virtual option separate form. The Institute Still looking for session moderators
- WSLS Executive Director, Frank Thousand, gave his 6 months' notice and a search is underway for a new executive director. More on this later
- President Meyer brought went to the Michigan Conference where he learned about the TWIST program. As a board we discussed this several years ago but passed on due to cost. I am interested in hearing what changes have been made to make it more affordable
- The Strategic plan as circulated was adopted
- Ryan Duckart has taken over as chair of the Trigstar Committee for the state

- NSPS had their spring meeting and form social media post I have seen the student competition was a lot of fun
- It was discussed on the voter turnout (143 of over 650 voting) for the WSLS Election, the outreach committee is looking into how to increase turn out
- Jeanette Harley is now the President of the Young surveyors. She has started out great with a lot of social media engagement including on Facebook and Linked in. They are focusing on exam prep
- The Outreach Committee will be proposing changes to the awards program
- Ad hock committee has been formed "Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Committee" headed by Emily Pierce. There charge is to review WSLS policies to make sure we are not inadvertently excluding individuals. If interested let me know and I will connect you with Emily
- Decluttering Franks Garage. WSLS in the transition
 will be looking though the files in franks garage to see
 what can be scanned and discarded vs what really
 needs to be kept. We would like some more seasoned
 membership with vast knowledge of the past to help
 with this purge
- Last week's meeting was to act on the recommendation of the ad hock committee to move forward with the Executive director recommendation

Young Surveyor Network (Conner Christopherson)

- Last meeting was held at 10am in conjunction with the WSLS Annual Institute on January 26, 2022
- Discussed Outreach opportunities including Future City, Scout Merit badge and Get Kids Into Surveying
- Guest speakers included Ed Harvet, Bryan Meyer, Dick Kleinman and Tim Burch
- Had a sponsored team at Bucky's Challenge
- Jeff DeMuth presented on the Wisconsin School Counselor Initiative
- Connor attended the NSPS Student Competition in Washington DC. Students were in charge of the event this year, with Les & Lisa Van Horn helping out

These CSMs were originally designed with the intent of giving people an easier alternative to a regular CSM. If not available, people may not do CSMs at all. The requirements are much looser than with a regular CSM.


