

- Last meeting was on June 5, 2010 in Marenisco, MI
- President Jimmy Rein recently attended the national convention in Phoenix. He attended many seminars on workshops. He also picked up the 1st Place plaque in the NSPS Map Plat Design contest awarded to Larry Blatchford of Mau & Associates. Congratulations Larry!
- The committees are working to get the CST more involved in WSLS including recognition of CSTs by including them in the regular membership category or a separate membership category
- The WSLS Summer meeting is in New Glarus this August. Fliers will be ready soon and circulated within the surveying community. Bill Wambach and Bill O'Conner will present programs
- The Board of Governors of NSPS have formed committees to look at the possible restructuring of the organization and its relationship with ACSM
- Foundation President Chrouser gave a financial report of the Foundation's past few years. Spending has outgrown income so far this year. He talked about the impacts of the Foundation's assets in TrigStar funding and expenses as well as what impacts it could have on scholarships


