Northeast Chapter of WSLS 2021 SUMMER GENERAL MEETING MINUTES July 22, 2021 – Hilly Haven G.C. in De Pere, WI

The 2021 Summer General Meeting was held on July 22, 2021 at Hilly Haven Golf Course in De Pere, WI. There were 44 members present, including 6 students, when Chapter President Howard Herrild introduced

SPECIAL PRESENTATION

- Cheryl Berken (Brown County ROD) and Sarah Van Camp (Outagamie County ROD) discussed the importance and nature of the Register of Deeds, including:
- Constructive notice is given when filing or recording a document, including death, birth and marriage records
- Ownership of rights in and claims on property constitute one of the chief forms of wealth in American society
- Local government property tax base is defined by the records of ROD. Accurate descriptions of property help avoid problems later
- The responsibilities of the office are set forth in the Wisconsin Statutes
- The general nature of ROD is described as ministerial. ROD has no discretion about whether or not to perform tasks required by Statutes. Nevertheless, an opinion of the Wisconsin Attorney General qualifies this general position somewhat
- The Attorney General says that the ROD must read the law and judge whether the law requires the ROD to perform a duty. In other words, the ROD must not assume that every document presented at the office must be recorded or filed. Judgements have to be made. Even more specifically, the Statutes require that the ROD judge whether plat documents meet the statutory criteria to be recorded
- The ROD must, from time to time, exercise judgement and decide whether statutory conditions are met before accepting a document

President Herrild thanked Cheryl & Sarah for the very informative presentation.

President Herrild then called the Summer General Meeting to order at 6:48 pm


