





July 20, 2023 – Woodfire Lodge in Brillion, WI

Robert R. Johanning

Robert Roland Johanning, a pillar of the Plymouth community, passed away on September 24, 2023, at the age of 91, at the Sharon S. Richardson Community Hospice. Born on December 18, 1931, in Plymouth, he was the son of the late Roland and Edna (Langner) Johanning. On December 1, 1956, he married the love of his life, Judith Kleinfeldt, at St. John Lutheran Church in Plymouth.

Robert's journey through life was marked by dedication, service, and commitment. He was a proud alumnus of Waldo High School and furthered his education at the University of Wisconsin – Madison. His sense of duty led him to enlist in the United States Army, where he served with honor and received an honorable discharge in 1953.

In 1959, Robert and Judy took the bold step of purchasing the family farm on Sumac Rd, embarking on a journey of hard work and family traditions. In 1965, he began his career with Donahue & Associates and, the following year, became a registered Wisconsin Land Surveyor. In 1972, he joined the leadership team at Aero Metric Engineering, where he served as Vice President until his well-deserved retirement in 1981. His dedication to his profession left an indelible mark on the field of land surveying.

Beyond his professional achievements, Robert was deeply involved in his community and church. He dedicated 14 years of service to the Sheboygan County Fair Board, served on the Lakeland Insurance board for four years, and devoted two decades to the Plymouth town and zoning boards. His expertise also extended to Calumet County, where he served as County Surveyor for nine years. In 1976, he assumed the role of President of the state board of Wisconsin Land Surveyors, a testament to his leadership and expertise in the field. Robert was a lifelong member of St. John Lutheran Church, where he served as board Vice President in the 1980s, further reflecting his commitment to his faith community.

Robert is survived by his six loving children: Rhonda (David) Bohnhoff, Ryan (Rose) Johanning, Barb (Jim) Iserloth, Ross (Shelly) Johanning, Scott (Kelly) Johanning, Jean (Michael) Schwabe and son-in-law Michael Gaynor. His legacy continues through his 22 cherished grandchildren and 18 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his beloved wife, Judy Johanning, his parents, Roland and Edna Johanning, his daughter Mary Gaynor, his brothers Roland Johanning Jr. and Kenneth Johanning, his sister Doreen Young, his grandson Daniel Gaynor, and his great-granddaughter Kaylyn Klahn.

Robert's contributions to his community, church, and profession will forever be remembered, and his legacy will live on through the hearts of those he touched.


